



Purpose:

The Fire Department activity accounts for the operations and administration of the Fire Department. The Red Wing Fire Department employs twenty-four career firefighters, a Fire Chief, Assistant fire Chief, Fire Marshal, Fire Inspector, Office Admin and thirty paid on call firefighters. Total staff of 29 full time and 30 paid on call.

In addition to providing fire prevention, public education and fire suppression services, the Fire Department provides Advanced Life Support (ALS) ambulance services for the City of Red Wing and neighboring communities in Minnesota. All Fire Department members are cross-trained for fire and emergency medical response.

Scope of Services:


- Provide Advanced Life Support services within a timely period
- Conduct Fire prevention and education activities
- Conduct Fire code enforcement actions
- Provide professional Firefighting and suppression service in a timely response period.
- Respond to hazardous materials incidents
- Respond to technical rescues
- Provide a standardized approach to the command, control, and coordination of emergency response.
- Preservation and protection of life, property and the environment against injury and damage from other incidents occurring within the City of Red Wing.

Purpose:

The Ambulance Fund is a self-sustaining fund, or enterprise fund of the city. The enterprise activities account for the operations of the Red Wing Ambulance Service. The Fire Department’s Ambulance Division provides Advanced Life Support ambulance services for the City of Red Wing and neighboring communities in Minnesota and Wisconsin totaling 285sq miles. All members are cross trained for fire and emergency medical responses achieving required certification.

Scope of Services:

- Provide advanced life support services
- Provide basic life support services
- Provide medical transportation from local medical facilities

- Conduct injury prevention and education
- Conduct CPR training and certification
- Timely response to mass casualty incidents
- Timely Response to hazardous materials incidents
- Preservation and protection of life, property and the environment against injury and damage from other incidents occurring within the City of Red Wing
