

Citizens are asked to continue their excellent efforts to transport private property leaves and brush to the community compost site at the solid waste campus (incinerator)



# 1/5 Outfall Inspections Annually






**Industrial SWPPP requires that drainage from the Yard Waste Compost Facility is recycled onto the compost.**
