2. Businesses and organizations which do not pay local property taxes:  
At bond closing, an administrative fee in the amount of 1/8 of one percent (0.125%) of the principal amount of the bonds, and annually thereafter 1/8 of one percent (0.125%) of the outstanding principal amount of the bonds. The administrative fee may be paid in a lump sum at bond closing, or may be paid semiannually while the bonds are outstanding at the times specified in the bond documents.

Permittee shall follow the rates and regulations on discharging sewage that are listed on the permit form.

**SUMMER RATES**

Definitions: RESIDENTIAL ACCOUNTS shall be defined as any single building with four or fewer residential units.

COMMERCIAL ACCOUNTS shall be defined as any building with five or more units or where the principal use of land or buildings is for the sale, lease, rental or trade of products, goods and services.

**RESIDENTIAL ACCOUNTS**

Residential accounts shall be billed the sewer portion in the following manner:

1. Sewer billing processed for the months of July, August, September and October's usage will be billed a maximum of 140 percent of the average billings for the previous eight months (November through June).
2. For accounts that do not have a history to base an eight-month average, the average monthly use should be deemed to be 600 cubic feet per month per household.
3. The minimum amount that must be used before any credit is allowed shall be 600 cubic feet per household.

## **COMMERCIAL NON-SEWER OR IRRIGATION ACCOUNTS**

Commercial non-sewer or irrigation accounts that would like to obtain an irrigation meter for the purpose of watering lawns and shrubs shall follow this procedure:

1. The property owner shall contact the Utilities Department to discuss the procedure and receive approval for an irrigation meter. The property owner shall provide proof that no water from the irrigation meter account will enter the city's sewer system.
2. Applicants for non-sewer or irrigation accounts shall be done by the property owner or association responsible official.
3. All irrigation or non-sewer accounts shall be done using auto-pay.
4. Account activation or set-up fees shall be charged each year. This fee is set annually.
5. An annual meter installation and removal charge will be established and annually set. The meters will be annually removed and reinstalled by the city at an annual fee of \$100.00 subject to annual adjustment through resolution adopting and affixing fees and licenses. Any winterization charges shall be billed at annual department rates plus 15% processing charges.
6. All meters shall have radio read MXU installed.
7. All meters shall be installed in either buried concrete manholes with a minimum diameter of 4 feet and at a minimum depth of 5 feet from finished grade or above-grade structures. Castings shall be Neenah No. 1772A with single concealed pick holes or other approved equivalent castings. All pits shall have proper drains or sump pumps, and protection to prevent flooding and submersion of back flow valves under water from leaks or infiltration. Structures shall conform to city standards. Above-grade meter and irrigation equipment housing structures shall provide a minimum of 4-feet by 4-feet wide and 6-feet high for meter servicing. Above-grade metal enclosures (coffins) will be permitted by special request. Locked facilities shall be fitted to accept standard city padlocks along with owner's locks to provide to the Public Works Department for access. Acceptable doubling lock systems are preferred. All entry shall conform to OSHA standard confined space entry requirements.
8. Existing non-conforming summer services are "grandfathered in" until such time as they are reconstructed or substantially rehabilitated and, at that time, shall be required to conform to standards.
9. All structures shall comply with applicable building and zoning codes. All irrigation systems shall comply with applicable plumbing codes and regulations.
10. Accounts will be billed along with other adjacent account billing cycles.
11. Each account will have an individual water service originating at the city watermain in the street with a curb stop shutoff at the property line along the street.
12. All systems are required to have RPZs or Reduced Pressure Zone backflow prevention devices. All backflow prevention devices shall be annually serviced and certified by appropriately licensed individuals.
13. Sprinkler or irrigation system record drawings of installed locations will be submitted to the Public Works Department for future reference.
14. If all the above stipulations are completed, the property owner will be billed for water usage and availability for this account.

# WATER RATES

Fees-- Annually - Unless Specified Differently

## **A. Water Rates:**

The consumers of city water shall pay to the City of Red Wing for water used or metered:

\$2.96 per 100 cu. ft.

## **B. Availability Charges:**

In addition to the above water rates, a monthly service charge will be made to every metered service where public water is available, whether water is used or not, based on the size of the water meter.

For a 5/8-inch meter:	\$10.20 per month
For a 3/4-inch meter:	\$10.20 per month
For a 1-inch meter:	\$13.25 per month
For a 1-1/2-inch meter:	\$24.50 per month
For a 2-inch meter:	\$38.25 per month
For a 3-inch meter:	\$73.50 per month
For a 4-inch meter:	\$115.75 per month
For a 6-inch meter:	\$231.50 per month

City water supplied through the one-inch and smaller meters shall be described as a "domestic account" and shall be paid bimonthly. City water supplied through meters larger than one-inch shall be described as a "commercial account" and shall be paid monthly.

In addition, the city at its discretion may charge a late fee for administration and labor fee costs associated with the shut-off procedure:

\$60.00 late fee

The city at its discretion may order the water shut off and services terminated. If the water is turned on after normal business hours, callback labor charges will be added to the late fee charge:

\$1: \$125.00 callback charge

An "account setup fee" will be charged on new accounts to defray the cost of setting up new accounts, meter installation, and verifying meter readings:

\$50.00 account setup fee

A charge will be made for operating any stop box for plumbing repair:

\$75.00 stop box charge

## **C. Bulk Water and Other Miscellaneous Use Rates and Fees:**

Minimum Charge:	\$20.00 per load
Standard Charge:	\$15.00 per 1,000 gallons loaded
Excess Usage:	\$6.00 per each additional 1,000 gallons loaded
Hydrant Meter Charge	\$10.00 per day \$75.00 setup fee Plus water usage

**D. Service Line and Street Rebuilding Charge:**

The city shall charge all applicants for water service line installations and connections done or made in the public streets or on public property as follows:

1. On all service line connections jointly made with the sewer service and the water line laid in the same trench as the sewer pipe and the digging is not done by the City of Red Wing Water Division, as per table illustrated:

60 feet or less:	\$1,200.00
60 to 80 feet:	\$1,500.00
80 to 100 feet:	\$1,800.00

2. On all installations where the digging of the trench is done exclusively by the City of Red Wing Water Division, as per the table illustrated:

60 feet or less:	\$1,500.00
60 to 80 feet:	\$1,800.00
80 to 100 feet:	\$2,100.00

On street reconstruction where all sewer and water service must be replaced due to age and condition, special costs will be charged as follows:

Sanitary sewer service and water service replacement during reconstruction (based on 100% of project costs):

6" PVC sanitary sewer service*:	\$1,500.00 each*
1" or smaller copper water service*:	\$1,500.00 each*
<i>* Fee reduced to \$1,200.00 each if sewer and water services are constructed through same project (20% savings).</i>	
8" or larger sanitary sewer service	Charge actual costs
1-1/2" or larger water service	Charge actual costs

All sanitary sewer services within the public right-of-ways or easements that are in excess of 40 years old are required to be mandatory replacement within areas of street or utility reconstruction.

All water services within the right-of-ways or easements that are constructed of galvanized pipe, cast iron pipe with lead joints, or other nonstandard materials shall require mandatory replacement within areas of street or utility reconstruction.

Where any service is installed exclusively by the Water Division and it is necessary to break up pavement or concrete, an additional charge shall be made based on the cost of restoring the street, driveway and sidewalk to its former condition, and a charge for the removal of concrete will be made:

Charge for removal of concrete:	\$6.00 per sq. ft.
Charge for frozen ground removal:	\$6.00 per sq. ft.

**D. Service Line and Street Rebuilding Charge, cont.**

On all service installations where larger than 3/4-inch pipe but smaller than 1-1/2-inch pipe is used, an additional charge shall be made and the additional charge shall be based on the actual increase in the cost of materials in excess of the cost of 3/4-inch pipe. On all service installations where 1-1/2-inch pipe or larger is used, the charge for the installation will be the actual cost of the labor and materials.

3. Annual Private Hydrant Inspection and Maintenance Charge: \$80.00 per hydrant
