Directions

Heading east on Hwy 61: Turn right at Hwy 58 heading south, turn left on 5th Street and follow the street under the Hwy 61 overpass to trail access point.

Heading west on Hwy 61: Turn left at Hwy 58 heading south, turn left on 5th Street and follow the street under the Hwy 61 overpass to trail access point.

Heading south on Hwy 63: Turn left at Hwy 58 heading south, turn left on 5th Street and follow the street under the Hwy 61 overpass to trail access point.

Heading north on Hwy 58: Turn right on 5th Street and follow the street under the Hwy 61 overpass to trail access point.
