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Top Goals for 2016:

- 1) Continue to support the Public Services Department with survey, design, neighborhood meetings, public hearings, staking, inspections, as-builds & assessments for the following projects:
 - Miscellaneous Storm Water Improvements.
 - Street/Alley reconstruction projects
 - a) 11th Street – From East Avenue westerly to end of street.
 - b) Alley – West of East Avenue, from 10th Street to 11th Street.
 - Various small projects throughout the city (C & G, CB, valley gutter replacements, etc.).
 - Bituminous reclamation of Memorial Park loop road.
 - Downtown street light study and replacement scheduling.

- 2) Develop/construct the following projects:
 - 2015/2016 TH 61 reconstruction (Old West Main Street to Potter Street with state funding assistance) – Construct phase 2 in 2016 (Broad Street to Potter Street).
 - 2015/2016 Levee Road reconstruction (state & federal aid project) – Reconstruct the roadway & utilities from Bay Point Park to Broad Street; reconstruct the small boat harbor wall & parking lot; and construct a multi-use trail from Bay Point Park to Broad Street.
 - 2016 city street reconditioning, mill & overlay project.
 - 2016 Residential Street Reconstruction Project – Complete reconstruction of segments of 13th, 14th, 15th, South Park, and Central Park Streets.
 - 2017 Residential Street Reconstruction Project – Survey and design in 2016 for complete reconstruction of segments of Fulton, Dakota, 5th, and 6th Streets.
 - 2017 Watermain Replacement Project on 21st Street – Survey and design in 2016.
 - 2017 Safe Routes to School project (federal aid) - Final design in 2016 (Pioneer Road/Twin Bluff Road intersection realignment, and pedestrian activated crosswalk flashers at various uncontrolled crossings).
 - 2017 Levee Wall Dockage and Park Improvements – Public involvement and design in 2016.
 - 2018 Spring Creek Rd/TH 61/Carol Lane/North & South Service Drives intersection realignment project (County, State, & Federal Aid) – Right-of-way acquisition and preliminary design in 2016.

- 3) Bridge Projects:
 - Sturgeon Lake Road Overpass – Final design completed in 2015. Pursuing State and Federal funding when opportunities arise.
 - 2017 thru 2019 TH 63 River Crossing Bridge replacement – Final design of bridge (MnDOT), and City utilities replacements; Assist public works with relocation efforts of maintenance building; and Oversee Xcel Energy's relocation of their high voltage underground electric line in 2016.
