Highway 61 (Main Street) Project – Watermain Utility Work

(May 6, 2015, Red Wing, Minn.) - The City of Red Wing and the Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT) would like to inform you that watermain utility work consisting of the operation of existing gate valves located within TH 61 at the intersections of Broad Street and Dakota Street are planned to take place starting at 9:00 am on Thursday, May 7th. The work is intended to be short in duration and will require temporary one way traffic along TH 61 between Franklin and Bush Street as directed by construction flaggers. As such travel delays are expected and motorists are encouraged if possible to find an alternate route during this time.
