- Safety & mobility issues exist with numerous accesses and heavy traffic volumes
- Connections from neighborhoods to river, across TH 61, are lacking/difficult
- Aesthetics to support commerce/tourism are limited


Public Involvement Approach


Final Cost Estimate = \$7.6 million








