

Introduction to Word Online - Tuesday, May 12th from 1:00 - 3:00 PM.


iPad for Beginners - Tuesday, May 19th and Friday, May 22nd from 1:00 - 3:00 PM.



Join the Friends of the Library on **Saturday, May 23rd @ 10 AM** in the Foot Room for this exciting presentation.




Summer Reading 2015:

The first reading log can be turned in on **Monday, June 15th**.




Minnesota Children's Museum Rochester
