




Tween Book Club


Friends of the Library Book Club


Romantic Movie Series : Joss Whedon's Much Ado About Nothing - PG-13



The library now offers two new genealogy research tools. Come into the library and access Ancestry.com. Ancestry.com lets you access a vast collection of U.S. and international documents online. Images of original documents enhance research and critical thinking. You can search over 30,000 Ancestry.com record collections and 11 billion records with a click of a button. This includes narratives, oral histories, indexes and abstracts to other resources spanning from the 1500s-2000s.

Unable to make it into the library? Then check out HeritageQuest Online from the library's website. HeritageQuest Online is a comprehensive treasury of American genealogical sources. It is rich in unique primary sources, local and family histories and finding aids. Discover the amazing history of you with HeritageQuest Online.
