- All fiber products may be put directly into the cart. This includes colored paper, inserts, catalogs, shiny paper and envelopes with or without a plastic window.
- Flatten boxes for better fit in the cart.
- Large volumes of cardboard can be brought to the Red Wing Solid Waste Campus.

- Cups
- Gift wrap
- Napkins
- Paper plates
- Paper towels
- Pizza boxes
- Waxy cardboard
- Wrapping paper

Plastics, Aluminum & Tin Cans

- Plastic, aluminum and tin cans may be put directly into the cart.
- All plastic bottles and food containers are acceptable (#1, #2, and #5).
- Please empty and rinse all containers before putting them in the cart.
- Red Wing Curbside Collection Program accepts only food and beverage containers. All aluminum types are accepted.

- Beer cans
- Coffee cans
- Food cans
- Ketchup bottles
- Laundry containers
- Milk jugs

Glass

- Recycle clear, brown and green/blue bottles and jars.
- Remove caps and lids from bottles and jars. Lids may be recycled (please leave them off jars), but metal caps are not recyclable.
- Please empty and rinse all bottles and jars before putting them in the cart.
